Present His Excellency the Governor. -

Benj. Hodder, Gabriel Duwall, James Brice & John H. Stone Esquires.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Thomas Smithers five hundred and eighty seven pounds, ten shillings and seven pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Certificates adjusted by the Aud^r General. -

That the said Treasurer issue a Certificate to John Setton agreeable to the Act proposing to the Citizens of this State, Creditors of Congress or Loan Office Certificates due for twelve pounds, seventeen shillings and nine pence due him on a Continental Loan Office Certificate adjusted by the Dep^y Aud^r. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Samuel Duwall One hundred and ten pounds sixteen shillings and one penny half penny specie in lieu of an Order on the Treasurer the 30th of December last in favor of George Dent for the like Sum, drawn agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State, and now returned. -

Ordered that Mr. Crisall deliver to Joseph Adams a Soldier in the Maryland Line one Shirt and one pair of Stockings and to Sepic Barnard also a Soldier in the Maryland Line one pair Stockings -

The General Assembly having authorized and empowered the Governor and Council by a resolve of the 23^d Instant to settle and adjust by arbitration the Dispute subsisting between this State and Captain Williams Stone relative to his Claim of the Brigantine Friendship, or any other matter depending thereon. -

Cols^o Samuel Smith and Majs^r John Steett and Daniel Bowley or any two of them are hereby nominated and appointed by Consent to enquire into said Dispute and make award thereon. -
