

M^r Charles Wharton a Native of this State, who left the same about twenty years ago for his Education, appeared this Day before the Board, and did take repeat and subscribe the Oath of Fidelity and Support to this State prescribed by the "Act to punish certain Crimes, and Misdemeanors, and to prevent the Growth of Tyranny."

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Matthew Sloan and George Poe two hundred and forty two Pounds, eight shillings and ten pence, and to George Poe one hundred and forty nine Pounds, fifteen shillings specie agreeably to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" & Act passed

That the said Treasurer pay to John Crisall two hundred and twenty six pounds, twelve shillings and eleven pence specie agreeably to the Act aforesaid per Certificate adjusted and passed the 28th January 1782.

That the said Treasurer issue a Certificate to John Crisall agreeably to the "Act proposing to the Citizens of this State, Creditors of Congress on Loan Office Certificate &c" for Twenty eight pounds, two shillings and seven pence due on Continental Loan Office Certificate adjusted by the said the 6th Inst.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Daniel of St. Thomas Jenifer Esq^r Two thousand, five hundred and thirteen pounds of Tobacco for the like Quantity lent the State in 1780 per Account passed. —

That the said Treasurer issue a Certificate to Samuel Davidson agreeably to the "Act proposing to the Citizens of this State, Creditors of Congress &c" for five hundred and forty one pounds and six pence due him on Continental Loan Office Certificate adjusted by the Deputy Aud^r the 12th Instant.

That the said Treasurer pay to Jeromiah P. Chase Esq^r Twenty pounds, twelve shillings and seven pence Current Money for one year Interest on four Certificates issued agreeably to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State." —

Samuel Chase Esquire appointed Agent and Trustee to receive and dispose of the Stock in the Bank of England, belonging to this State, this Day executed and lodged a Bond with approved Security agreeably to the Directions of the "Act concerning the Stock of the Bank of England, belonging to this State." —

Present the Honorable James Davis and John A. Stone Esquires. —

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to John Crisall seven pounds, ten shillings Current Money, out of the Money put into the Treasury for procuring necessaries for the Hospital on Account. —
