There being no Lieutenants of Counties as heretofore when the Law passed for raising the select the late Collector of Prince Georges County is requested to pay an account of Captain Osburn Williams and his Company of Select Militia for services performed by them in the Year 1781, amounting to Fifty four Pounds, eleven shillings and three pence which will be received by the Treasurer as specie. -

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to the following Persons the sums respectively annexed to their names agreeably to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" Capt^r Nicholas White four hundred and fifty three pounds ten shillings and eight pence - Capt Daniel Rheintzol One hundred and forty four pounds eight shillings and four pence per pay rolls passed 12 Oct. 1782. Capt Nicholas White One hundred and twenty two pounds, six shillings and eight pence per pay roll passed 27 Decem^r last - Richard Sheekle six pounds, four shillings and six pence per account passed 26th Feb^r last - Jacob Levy Fifteen pounds, eighteen shillings and ten pence per pay roll passed 29th April last - William Rizzo Seven pounds, three shillings and four pence per account passed 31st May last - Ulrich Henninger Representative of George Henninger nine pounds, ten shillings per account passed 16th Instant and Jacob Schley and John Shellenham Junr. Seven pounds, five shillings & ten pence per Certificate passed 13th March 1783. -
