Present His Excellency William Pava Esquire Governor &c

The Honorable James Bruce Esquire -

Ordered that the Western Shore Treasurer pay to His Excellency Governor Pava Three hundred Pounds for six Months Salary -

and that the said Treasurer pay to Alexander C. Harvon One hundred Pounds (more or less) for 1 Quarter's Salary ending the 1st July last

Friday 4th July 1783.

Thomas Jenning Esq. exhibits an Account against the Estate of Lloyd Dulany forfeited amounting with Interest thereon to Thirty seven pounds sixteen shillings and eleven pence Sterling passed by the Aud. General and approved by this Board.
