That the said Treasurer pay to Richard Sprigg for the use of Edward Jones one of the Judges of the Court of Appeals Fifty Pounds Current Money for a Quarter Salary. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Captain William Campbell four thousand five hundred and fifty nine pounds of Tobacco at Saint Marys Warehouse for the like Quantity including Interest lent the State by Mark Alexander the 10<sup>th</sup> July 1780 per Certificate adjusted by the Depy Aud. —

That the said Treasurer issue a Certificate to William Douglass agreeably to the Act proposing to the Citizens of this State Creditors of Congress due for five hundred and twenty one Pounds three shillings and two pence due him on Continental Loan this Certificate adjusted by the Depy Aud. —
