Twenty seven pounds, thirteen shillings and six pence

Henry Jackson against the same for Seventy three pounds four shillings
and eleven pence - Stephen Miller against the same for Thirty nine pounds
three shillings and three pence, and Jacob Ransburg against the same for
Twenty seven pounds ten shillings. - which Accounts are rejected, because Mr
Dulany had contracted with Mr. Anderson for the building his House by whom all
Contracts were made and to whom Application must be made for Payment &
it appearing that Mr Dulany fully paid Anderson. -

On considering the Justices Return of the Election for Sheriffs of
Local County, and Letters from sundry Inhabitants of said County complaining that
the Election was not made fairly and agreeable to the Constitution, and requesting
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
