

Monday November The 4th 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Arthur The John Davidson, James Thomas and Jonathan R. Wilmer.

Henry Whitefoot was appointed Notary Public for Prince Georges County in the room of Washington Boyd resigned, and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gabriel Durall Esquire, The sum of one hundred and eighty seven pounds ten shillings for one quarters salary as a Judge of the General Court; due the first instant.

Tuesday November The 5th 1799

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Arthur Theaoff, John Davidson, James Thomas and Jonathan R. Wilmer.

John Schoofield was appointed Inspector of Tobacco at Roke to the Warehouse in Somerset County and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to General Uriah Forrest the sum of thirty three pounds fifteen shillings for one quarters half pay; due the first instant.

By the Petition of Nailor Harbin of Montgomery County it appears that he was presented at the Court of the said County for retailing spirituous liquors without licence. The Petitioner states that he is poor and has a large family depending on him for support. He prays to be released from the fine of six pounds that was imposed on him. The Board on consideration and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the same.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Abraham Gambell, seven pounds five shillings for five quarters half pay; due the first instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mr. John Shaw the sum of one hundred and eighty pounds nineteen shillings and nine pence it being the balance of an account passed by the Auditor.

James Wilson was appointed Surveyor of Talbot County in the room of Peter Henson dead, and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Lynn thirty pounds for six Months half pay; due the first instant.

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Perry Benson forty five pounds for six Months half pay; due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Captain James Somerville, twenty two pounds ten shillings for one quarters half pay; due as above.
