

Monday May the 11. 1801

The Council met. Present The Honble Thomas Buchanan, James Thomas, John Davidson
and Samuel Oidout.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Miah Fourest the
sum of thirty three pounds fifteen Shillings current Money, for one quarters half pay:
due the first instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to James Fowan Printer at Easton, the
sum of twenty pounds one Shilling and three pence, for printing done for the
State; as per account passed by the Auditor.

Tuesday May the 12. 1801

The Council met. Present The Honble Thomas Buchanan, Arthur Shaaff
James Thomas, John Davidson and Samuel Oidout.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Shaw the
sum of thirty three pounds eleven Shillings and ten pence current Money,
as per account passed by the Auditor.

Thursday May the 14.

The Council met. Present The Honble Thomas Buchanan, James Thomas
and John Davidson.

By a Representation from Frederick County Court it appears that Henry
Cable Junior, was presented, at April Term last for selling liquors
without licence. The Court state that the said Cable submitted on
all the Presentments and was fined in each the sum of six pounds. The
Court further state that it was proved that Cable had obtained a licence
from the collector of the County under the law of Congress imposing a Tax on
retailers licence, and that he violated the law of this State through
ignorance. They therefore recommend a Pardon of the same.
The Board on consideration of which circumstances do remit the whole
of fifty two pines.
