The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honble Francis Digges, Allen B. Duckitt, Beverly Gibson and Edward Hall

Vachel Dossy was appointed Inspector of Tobacco at the New Warehouse at the Head of the Basin in Baltimore County and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Nicholas Brewer was appointed Notary Public for Anne Arundel County vice William Brown resigned and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Raphael Neal was appointed a Justice of the Orphans Court for Saint Marys County vice William Sommers resigned and Commission issued accordingly to Edmund Plowden, Henry Gardner and Raphael Neal as Justices of the Orphans Court for the said County.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Thomas Dobbin, the sum of ten pounds four shillings and four pence half penny, for printing done for the State; as per account paid.

Ordered, that Nicholas White heretofore appointed Armour at Frederick Town be allowed the sum of eighty four pounds in full of all demands for his salary and Charges and Expenses in putting in order and keeping in repair the Arms under his direction until the first day of May next and that he be allowed for like services, at the rate of Ninety six pounds until the first day of November next (unless sooner discharged by the Executive) to be paid quarterly, the first quarter to be paid on the first day of August next.

Ordered, that Mr. John Shaw be directed to purchase a New Stand of Colours for the State and that not more than Seventy Dollars be appropriated for that purpose out of the contingent Fund.
