By a Representation from the Associate Justices of Harford County Court it appears that Joseph Hay of the said County entered into several Bail Bonds in the penal sum of fifty pounds each for the appearance of a certain Lolis Curtis arrested upon several Writs of Habeas Corpus out of said Court against him upon Presentments for Assaults and Batteries. - that upon the return of said Writs to wit at August Term 1798 the said Curtis did not appear whereupon the said Bonds were forfeited. - that the said Curtis absconded and has left the State and they have reason to believe that the said Hay has used all means in his power to have him brought to Justice and they having recommended a Remission of the same advised that the said Hay be released from such parts of the said penalties as are still unpaid.

By a Representation from the Chief and two Associate Justices of Talbot County Court it appears that William Dawson was fined at June Term instant the quantity of two thousand pounds of Tobacco for selling strong Liquor on a Sunday. - they state that the Jury which was very respectable conceiving the testimony unreasonable, and differing in their opinions as to the credibility of some of the Witnesses were in their Chamber a day or two nights before they could agree and when they gave in their Verdict conceiving it a hard case they requested the Court to interfere in favour of Dawson, with the Executive. - they state that he is poor. - they recommend a Remission of three fourths. - The Board on consideration do remit three fourths of the said fine.
