Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Miriam Pinkney the Sum of fifteen shillings it being the amount paid by him to Francis Fairbrother on account passed and receipt filed with the Auditor.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to the Honble Allen. B. Duckitt, the Sum of fifty pounds for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council due the first instalment.
