Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to the Honble John Dore, the sum of one hundred and eighty seven pounds ten shillings, for one quarters Salary as Judge of the General Court, due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to M. Partgis, Esquire, ten pounds fifteen shillings and four pence half penny, for printing done for the State by order of the Governor and Council, as per account paid.
