The Petitioner further states that she sold Spirituous liquors to some of her Neighbours on the second day of March eighteen hundred and two without a Licence not knowing that it was contrary to law: She therefore prays to be released from the said fine. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the said Court: do writt

That at the usual time of stating out Licence, he was on the Western Shore attending Court business, and through the defect of his recollection did not obtain one, as he meant to do: That his offence arose from the above cause and not from a wish to violate the law. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do writt free of the said fines dislinguished by Nos 19. 20. 21. 22. and 24 on the said Robert Sumner paying the Cost of the Licence.
