Ordered, that the Proceedings of the Council shall be regularly entered on a Journal each day, and that on the succeeding day, previous to any other act, the same shall be read over by the Clerk, and signed by the Governor or the Member of the Council presiding before which any Member of the Board may move to reconsider any part thereof which may not have been carried into execution, and the same shall be considered as subject to alteration by a subsequent vote of the Council.

Ordered, that in making all appointments, the same shall be decided by Ballot, if required by any Member, and upon all other questions, the opinion of the Board shall be taken by the Governor or presiding Member of the Board, beginning with the last named Member, and so proceeding till the question is decided, and if required by a Member, the question shall be stated, and the names entered in the affirmative or negative as they shall respectively vote.
