The Council resumed the consideration of the appointment of Justices of the Peace and other officers directed by the Constitution and Laws to be appointed annually and not having come to a conclusion postponed the further consideration thereof till to morrow.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Allen B. Duckett, Francis Digges, Pervady Ghislin and Edward Hall.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John B. Colven Esquire out of the Contingent Fund thirty seven dollars and seventy five cents for printing done for the State as per account passed.

A demand was made on the Governor of Pennsylvania for Samuel Banks otherwise called Samuel Black a fugitive from the Justice of this State

Wednesday December 7 1803
