The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Allen. B. Duckett, Francis Digges, Purdy Ghieslin and Edward Hall.

By the Petition of Robert Harris of Caroline County accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he was fined by Caroline County Court at October Term last on three presentments for selling spirituous liquors without licence the sum of six pounds on each. - The Petitioner states that he removed from Virginia to Caroline County about the latter end of last year and on the first day of January last engaged a House and opened a Store for the sale of Groceries and other goods: that being a stranger to the laws and regulations of this State with respect to merchandising, was ignorant of the act of Assembly which required him to obtain a licence. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the whole of the said fines.
