The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Allen B. Duckett, Davidson David and Edward Hall.

By the Petition of William Tomkins and John H. Tomkins of Charles County it appears that they entered into a Recognizance in the sum of thirty pounds for the appearance of William Tomkins before the Justices of Charles County Court and in the mean time to keep the Peace with Mary Farn. The Petitioner states that the said Recognizance was forfeited at March Term eight hundred and two. The Petitioners further state that before the forfeiture of the said Recognizance Mary Farn agreed to withdraw her complaint against the said William Tomkins and owing to that circumstance he considered it unnecessary to attend the Court supposing the Recognizance had been finally disposed of and knowing also that Mary Farn would not appear against him. They therefore pray to be released from the said forfeiture.
