Saturday January the 7 1804

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Council.

Thomas Linsted and Robert Smith were appointed Justices of the Orphans Court for Montgomery County vice Samuel Griffith and William Wilson resigned and Commission issued to Honour Martin, Thomas Linsted and Robert Smith as Justices of the Orphans Court of said County.

Warren Magruder was appointed a Justice of the Levy Court of Montgomery County vice Thomas Linsted appointed in the Orphans Court and Commission issued to the said County including him and leaving out Thomas Linsted.

New Commission issued to Baltimore including Samuel H. Gatchell as a Justice of the Peace for said County, and leaving out James Brays who declines accepting.

New Commission of the Peace issued to Frederick County including Henry Williams.
