The Petitioner states that after he had recognized as aforesaid he sold the said James to a certain George W. of Putt of the said County, and that he could not conveniently produce him at the said Term. The Petitioner further states that he entered into a Recognizance to produce the said James at the November Term following at which time he was arraigned tried and convicted. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do omit the said forfeited Recognizance.
