Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Nicholas White, for his services as Armour at Frederick Town from the first day of November to the first day of May instant the sum of Ninety six pounds current Money and that the said Nicholas White be continued as Armour till the first day of November next on the same terms and conditions, on which he has hitherto held the said appointment.

By the Petition of Gervial Williams of Harford County it appears that he has been fined by the Court of the said County on two several Indictments for selling liquor without Licence and that the said fines were imposed at August Term 1803. that he then gave security for the fines and fees - that Executions have issued against him and that he has been in confinement under the same since August last. that his health is very much impaired being sick since the day of confinement - that he has a Wife and a number of small Children and that a rigorous execution of the fine in his state of poverty and ill health would be attended with entire ruin to himself and family. - The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the same.
