from playing Ball in the State House or committing any Trespass on the said Public Building
and if unable to prevent the same, that he give information to this Board of the persons that
may be guilty of such Trespasses, that legal steps may be pursued for the preservation of
the public property.

ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honorable Davidson David, the
sum of fifty pounds, for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council: due the first
instant.

ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honorable John Bone, five
hundred Dollars, for one quarters salary as Judge of the General Court: due as above.

Ghiselin and Edward Hall.

Charles Swall by the decision of the Council is intitled to a preference in so much of
the Tract of Land lying in Charles County called Beauty as is now in possession of
said Swall he having been the first applicant.

ordered, that the said Swall be intitled to the States right to said land on
passing his Bond to the said State with such security as the Treasurer shall approve
of for such sum as the same may amount to, at fifty shillings per acre for the States
right. The said sum per acre being inclusive of the one third to which the said Swall
is intitled by law.

ordered, that unless the said Swall pass his Bond as aforesaid on or before the
first day of July next, he shall not be intitled to any benefit or preference under the
foregoing order.
