The Council sold the States Right to the foregoing lands for the sum of fifteen hundred pounds current Money to George Funch provided he give Bond with such security as the Treasurer may approve on or before the fifteenth day of July next, conditioned for the payment of seven hundred and fifty pounds current Money on or before the sixth day of May 1805 and for the payment of the further sum of seven hundred and fifty pounds on or before the sixth day of May 1806. Interest on the whole sum of fifteen hundred pounds from this day until the first Installment with Interest is discharged, and then on the second Installment from the payment of the first Installment and Interest.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The honorable Allen. B. Duckett Edward Chesler and Edward Hall and Francis Duggis

Philip Ford was appointed a Justice of the orphans Court for Saint Marys County vice Edmund Plowden deceased and Commission issued to Raphael Neal James Gorton and Philip Ford as Justices of the orphans Court for said County.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Wilmet out of the Contingent Fund five pounds twelve shillings and six pence for riding Exp<sup>s</sup> to the Sheriff of Charles County as per account passed.
