Saturday June the 16. 1804

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honorable Francis Digges, Edward Hall and Purdy Cheslin.

Resolved that the order of the fifth of June relative to the sale of a Tract or Parcel of land to Charles Swall called Beauty lying in Charles County be revoked, and that the said Charles Swall be entitled to all the right and Interest of the State to the said land on passing his Bond to the State with such security as the Treasurer shall approve for such sum as the same may amount to at eighteen shillings and nine pence per acre payable in twelve months from the date thereof.

Ordered that unless the said Swall pass his Bond as aforesaid on or before the first day of August next he shall not be entitled to any benefit or preference under the foregoing order.

Jacob Walters was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Patterson County and a new Commission issued to the said County him.
