

The State of Maryland to the Sheriff of Allegany County Genting. Whereas by the death of Daniel Huston Coquire communicated by a letter from the honorable Nathaniel Macon Speaker of the House of Representatives of the United States dated the eighth day of March last, a vacancy has arisen in the Representation of this State in the House of Representatives of the United States, which vacancy according to an act of asembly passed at November Session seventeen hundred and ninety entitled an act directing the time place and manner of holding Elections for Representatives of this State in the Congress of the United States, and for appointing Electors on the part of this State for choosing a President and Vice President of the United States, and for the regulation of the said Elections and also to repeal the act of asembly therein mentioned and according to another act of the General Assembly supplementary to the act aforesaid passed at November Session seventeen hundred and ninety one must be filled by a person resident within and elected by the qualified Voters of the fourth District of this State as designated by the said acts of asembly. We do therefore in pursuance of the powers vested in us by the acts aforesaid and the act to regulate Elections passed at November Session seventeen hundred and ninety nine, authorize and command you to appoint a day to hold an Election in your County of Allegany for a Representative of this State to fill the vacancy in the House of Representatives of the United States occasioned by the death of the aforesaid Daniel Huston Coquire, and the said Election shall be held within fifteen days after the receipt of this Warrant, and you shall serve a copy thereof on each of the Judges in each Election District of your County at least seven days before the day appointed for holding such Election.
