

Thomas Jefferson President of the United States to all whom it may concern
The Citizen Arcambal, having produced to me his Commission as Commissioner of Commercial
Relations of the French Republic, at Baltimore, I do hereby recognize him as such, and
declare him free to exercise such functions Powers and privileges as are allowed to the
similar Agents of the most favoured Nations. In Testimony whereof I have caused these
letters to be made patent, and the Seal of the United States to be hereunto affixed.
Given under my hand at the City of Washington, the twenty third day of May, in the
Year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and four, and of the Independence of
the United States of America, the twenty eighth.

Ordered, that the foregoing order and Signature be published twice in each Week for
the space of three Weeks successively in the Maryland Gazette at Annapolis, the Federal
Gazette and American at Baltimore.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry H. Harwood
Esquire, the sum of thirty Dollars for attending the Eastern Shore General Court.

Whereas Negro Sam commonly called Samuel Gunwell the Slave of William
Wallace, Esquire, of Charles County, was tried and convicted of Murder and was by the
Court of the said County at March Term last sentenced to suffer death which said
sentence was commuted by his Excellency the Governor on the thirtieth day of June
last to labour on the public Roads of Baltimore County for the term of twenty Years -
Therefore ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the said William
Wallace, Esquire, the sum of three hundred dollars, the valuation of the said Negro
Sam.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Shaw or order
the sum of sixty five pounds one shilling and nine pence it being the Balance due
on his account after deducting from said Account the sum of four pounds four
shillings and four pence half penny charged as a Commission for reporting to the
Assembly an estimate of Repairs to the Treasury, and the sum of seven pounds ten
shillings deducted from the charge for taking care of the Arms and Military Stores.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honorable John Bone the
sum of five hundred dollars for three Months salary as Judge of the General
Court due this day

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honorable Francis Biggs,
fifty pounds for one quarter's salary as a Member of the Council due as above.
