It was thereupon ordered, that the said Treasurer be requested, to furnish John Stephen, Esquire of the City of Baltimore with the necessary documents and Information for the effectual recovery of said claim and engage said Stephen as attorney for the State in the prosecution of the same, and request him to advise with the attorney General on the steps proper to be taken for the recovery thereof.

Ordered, that the administrator of N. Smith late Sheriff of Calvert County be indulged until the first day of August for the payment of the claims due from his Intestate to the State.
