Saturday March the 2 1805

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Richard Hall Harwood, Allen B. Luskett, Rowdy Chesdin and Richard T. Carl.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Eastern Shore be directed to take such steps respecting the Judgments obtained against Samuel T. Wright Clerk of Lunenburg County as he may think best for the interest of the State.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Eastern Shore be directed to bring suit against Samuel T. Wright, Esquire, Clerk of Lunenburg County for the sum of one hundred and thirty eight Dollars due to the State of Maryland for College Funds to the first of March Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Eastern Shore be directed to bring suit against John Wilkins late Sheriff of Somerset County, for the sum of five hundred and thirty seven Dollars and forty two cents due to the State for College Funds and forth.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Eastern Shore be directed not to bring suits against the following State Debtors for their respective balances up to the first of March Instant Samuel Couden, James Cochrane, Cutbert Hall, Robert Leatherbury, William Moffitt, Robert Navin, Thomas James Patterson, James Sumners and Philimon Willis.

Percy Benson, Esquire, was appointed a Justice of the orphans Court for Talbot County vice Docta Pitt resigned and Commission issued to William Dawson, William Thomas and Percy Benson as Justices of the orphans Court of the said County.

Frederick Holbrook was appointed a Justice of the duty Court for Caroline County vice Peter Plisk dead and New Commission issued to the said County including him.
