The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Council.

Samuel G. Osborn was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Lunenburg County and Commission issued to the said County including him.

William Whitley Coquiri was appointed a Justice of the Levy Court for Caroline County vice Friedrich Holbrook who would not accept.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the legal Representative of Mr. William Farris three pounds eleven Shillings and six pence out of the Contingent Fund for repairing and attending the Clock at the Government House as per account papered by the Auditor.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mrs. Pucilla Farris out of the Contingent Fund eleven Shillings and three pence for repairs to the Clock at the Government House as per account papered by the Auditor.

Ordered that no suit be commenced against Gapaway Wathens a State Debtor until after the first day of June next.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore be directed not to bring suit against Jasper C. Tully Sheriff of Anne Arundel County a State Debtor until the first day of April next.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore be directed not to issue execution on the Judgment obtained against John H. Stone, Charles Wallau, Allen Lupton and John Murr Securities of Cornubius Mills until the first day of September next.

Thomas Jennings Coquiri was appointed an associate Justice for Anne Arundel County vice Archibald Boney removed and Commission issued to Isaac Boney and Thomas Jennings as associate Justices for the said County.
