

Friday May the 3<sup>rd</sup> 1804.

His Excellency The Governor and The Honble Richard Hall Harwood and Rowdy Ghislin  
appeared in The Council Chamber.

Monday May 16 1805

The Council met. Present The Honble Richard Hall Harwood, Allen B. Suckett and  
Rowdy Ghislin.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mrs Ann de Washer, fifteen pounds,  
for one quarters half pay due as the first Instant.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Trueman, fifteen  
pounds for one quarters half pay due the first Instant.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Captain Perry Benson twenty two pounds  
ten Shillings for one quarters half pay due the first Instant.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honble Thomas Jones Ninety  
three pounds fifteen Shillings for one quarters Salary as Judge of the Court of Appeals due  
the first Instant.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to the honble Rowdy Ghislin, fifty pounds,  
for one quarters Salary as a Member of the Council: due the first Instant.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to the honble Richard Hall Harwood,  
fifty pounds for one quarters Salary as a Member of the Council due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to the honble Allen B. Suckett, fifty  
pounds, for one quarters Salary as a Member of the Council: due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Mr John Wilmot, three pounds fifteen  
Shillings and seven pence, for riding Exp<sup>ts</sup> to his Excellency the Governor, as per account  
passed by the Auditor.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Mr John Wilmot, out of the Contingent  
Funds three pounds fifteen Shillings and ten pence half penny for riding Exp<sup>ts</sup> to  
the Governor, as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Frederick Gunn Coopers, thirty pounds,  
for printing done for the State as per account passed.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Mr M. Sigill one dollar and twenty  
five Cents for books furnished for the use of the Council as per account passed.

Edward Hall of Isaac was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Anne Arundel  
County and a New Commission issued to the said County including him.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr Jubb Fowler twenty four  
seven Shillings and three pence as per account passed by the Auditor.
