The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Richard Hall Harwood, Allen B. Suckett and Beverly Chesden.

Ordered that Richard West Esquire of Prince Georges County be authorized to receive collect and receipt for the Public Arms and accoutrements that were delivered to the Select Company attached to the 14 Regiment and that he cause the same to be deposited in Nottingham and that all expenses necessary for the collecting and removing the said Arms be defrayed by the Public.

Thomas Thistle was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Allegany County and a New Commission issued to the said County including him and leaving out John Bone.

By the Petition of Amint M. Allen, Robert B. Henson, John Davis, John McAffie, John Harmon, Charles Burnett, Henry Puss and Edward Davis of the City of Baltimore accompanied by a Transcript of the Proceedings of Baltimore County General Court it appears that they were fined by the said Court at November Term last the sum of ten pounds current Money each for selling liquors without License. The Petitioners state that they were all duly licensed as Tavern Keepers at the time of the laston Races in October last near the City of Baltimore and fully believing that they might with propriety so do, they kept Booths at said Races and sold liquors without having obtained a Special License for that purpose. The Petitioners further state that having Tavern Licenses they fully believed that they might sell liquors at such times and places without any other or Special License and that such had been the practice for many years previous that they never heard of any other License being necessary or that any person was ever presented. They therefore pray to be released from the said fines. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fines.
