In virtue of a Resolution of October Session foregoing hundred and eighty The Governor orders and directs that Mrs. Rebecca Forest Widow of Break Forest late deceased, formerly a Lieutenant Colonel in the Continental Service of the United States of the Quota of the State of Maryland Troops in that service be allowed half pay from the sixth day of July last during her life to be drawn quarterly by order on The Treasurer of the Western Shore.

Thursday October The 17. 1805

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and The Honble Richard Hall Harwood, Allen. B. Buckett and Francis Siggins.

Ordered that The Vendition Exponas issued to Harford County against John Love and his Secutors at Suit of the State of Maryland be permitted to be returned by the Sheriff of said County not executed. The Money being levied upon Harford County in virtue of an Act of Assembly passed last Session, and payable by the Collector of the Public Taxes in said County on or before the twentieth day of February next.

William Bradley Beanes was appointed a Justice of the Orphans Court of Prince Georges County vice Samuel Tyler deceased and Commission issued to Thomas F. Brooke, Benjamin Oden and William Bradley Beanes as Justices of the Orphans Court of said County.

The Council direct that The Attorney General have The Executions which issued out of The General Court against Charles Manheim entered on The docket not called by consent.
