The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and The Honble Richard Hall Harwood, Allen. B. Buckett and Rowdy Chesler

By The Petition of Rudolph Haburstick of Allegany County accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he was presented at a previous Term East on three several presentments for selling Spirituous Liquor without License and was fined by the said Court at October Term following six hundred pounds of Tobacco on each. The Petitioner states that he had some time before taken out License from Hanson Bruce, Esquire one of the Associate Justices of Allegany County to keep a Public House of Entertainment which he believed authorized him to sell Liquor. The Petitioner states on oath that he violated the law from ignorance and not design. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fine.

Monday November The 11. 1805

The Council met. Present The Honble Richard. H. Harwood, Allen. B. Buckett and Rowdy Chesler.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Shaw one hundred and fifty two pounds nine shillings and five pence half penny it being a balance due him as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mr. John Wilmot six pounds sixteen shillings and four pence half penny as per account passed by the Auditor.
