

Thursday November the 21: 1805

The Council met Pursant His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Allen B. Buchett, Rowdy G. Childer and Philip Reid.

James G. Wood was appointed a Justice of the Ophans Court for Prince Georges County vice William B. Beans who would not accept and Commission issued to Thomas F. Brooke, Benjamin Oden and James G. Wood as Justices of the Ophans Court for said County.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Shaw one hundred pounds to purchase Wood for the General Assembly

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Wilson five pounds thirteen Shillings and five pence for riding Expence to the Sheriff of Calvert County as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honble Benjamin Rumsey Ninety Three pounds fifteen Shillings for one quarters Salary as Judge of the Court of Appeals due the first Instant

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honble John Sime the sum of five hundred Dollars for one quarters Salary as Judge of the General Court due as above.

By the Petition of Joshua Sedwick of Calvert County accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he was fined at April Term last on two Permittments the sum of six pounds Current Money each for selling Spirituous Liquor contrary to Law. The Petitioner states that he has long been engaged in the distilling and sale of Liquor from produce raised on his own farm. That he was prevailed on by one Abraham Mowatt of the same place to let him have two pints of apple Brandy for which the said Permittments originated - that on examination of the Law he finds he was restricted to sell not less than one quart. The Petitioner further states that he has always conducted himself with propriety and that he violated the Law from ignorance. That the payment of the fines would be very inconvenient to him. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fines.
