The Honorable Francis Siggins a Councillor elect appeared in the Council Room, and was qualified as such agreeably to the Constitution and laws of this State before Richard Menden, Esquire a Justice of the Peace for Anne Arundel County by taking repeating and subscribing the several Oaths and the declaration provided for that purpose as well as the Oath to support the Constitution of the United States. Friday December the 13. 1805

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Allen B. Buckett, Rowdy Ghiselin, Richard T. Earle and Francis Siggins.

Charles Shanks was appointed and commissioned Surveyor of Saint Marys County.

Ordered, that the Clerk of the Council procure for the use of the Governor and Council, the Votes and Proceedings of the General Assembly from the time of the adoption of the Constitution of this State and that the same be bound up and kept in the Council Room.

The Council postponed the further consideration of Justices of the Peace and other officers of annual appointment till to Morrow.
