Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Wilcox three pounds fourteen Shillings and nine pence half penny for riding as Counsel to William Anthony Coopers with a notification of his appointment as Attorney General as per account passed by the Auditor.

William Brannon was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Charles County and Commission issued including him.

The Council postponed the further consideration of Justices of the Peace and other officers of annual appointment till to Morrow.
