Thomas Paulberry was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Caroline County and
a New Commission issued to the said County including him and leaving out Peter
Puck

By the Petition of William Moody of Baltimore County accompanied by a Transcript
from the Proceedings of the Criminal Court of the said County it appears that he entered
into a Recognizance in the sum of twenty pounds for the appearance of Henrietta
Moody his Wife at the Court of Oyer and Terminer and Gaol Delivery for Baltimore
County at November Term eighteen hundred and three as a Witness against a certain
Charles Myers on a charge of Murder. The Petitioner states that the said Henrietta
Moody did appear at the said Term and was sworn as a Witness to the Grand Jury
and gave unto said Jury all her knowledge of the circumstances. The Petitioner fur-
ther states that the said Charles Myers was not there nor has he since been arrested
that the said Henrietta Moody after having gone before the Grand Jury continued
still from time to time to attend said Court and all the subsequent Terms of said
Court until July Term eighteen hundred and five and that she also attended a part
of the last mentioned Term. But believing that her constant attendance there
could not be necessary as the said Charles Myers had not been arrested, he was
occasionally absent from Court. The Board on consideration of which circum-
stances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do
warrant the said Justice
