

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Robert Denny Esquire, twenty five pounds, for one quarter salary as Auditor General: due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honorable Richard Telfman Esq., fifty pounds for one quarter salary as a Member of the Council: due the fifteenth instant.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to the honorable Philip Aud, the sum of fifty pounds, for one quarter salary as a Member of the Council: due the first instant.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Mr Edward Roberts, twenty four Dollars and forty three and one half cents, for riding Expens, as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messrs Luby and Davis thirty pounds for repairs to the Chancery Office as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Norman Pinhook eighty nine pounds twelve shillings as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore be directed not to issue execution against Benjamin Lawood and Sureties until the first day of August next.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Ann Lebacher, fifteen pounds, for one quarter half pay, due the first instant.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Mr Joseph Dawson, three pounds fifteen shillings for one quarter half pay, due the first instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Norman Pinhook, twenty five pounds, for one quarter salary as Clerk of the Council: due the first instant.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Benjamin Rumsey Esquire, thirty one pounds five shillings for salary due as Judge of the late Court of Appeals to the thirtieth of November last.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Thomas W. Hall Esquire, fourteen pounds one shilling and three pence, for one quarter salary as Clerk of the Senate: due the first instant.

By the Petition of Gunbury Wilson accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of Baltimore County Criminal Court it appears that he entered into a Recognizance before Robert Gossuch Esquire, one of the Justices of the Peace of the said County in the sum of twenty pounds current Money for his appearance before the Justices of the Court of Oyer and Terminer and Good Behavior for Baltimore County on the first Monday in November last to answer a charge against him for swindling Charles Goss of eight Dollars. The Petitioner states that at the time the said Court was in Session he was under the necessity of going to the State of Pennsylvania, that during his absence his Recognizance was called and forfeited and on his return he was arrested and is now under execution for the amount thereof. That he has entered into a new Recognizance with security approved of by the said Court and is now waiting his trial. That inasmuch as there has not been a failure of Justice he prays to be released from the said penalty. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said forfeiture of twenty pounds.
