

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Edward Roberts three pounds fifteen shillings for riding Express to Charles County as per account passed by the Auditor.
The Honble Allen Bowie Luchett having resigned his Seat in Council. The Board proceeded immediately thereupon to elect another Member in his place the Ballots being deposited in the Ballot Box and on examination thereof it appeared that Thomas W. Hall had a Majority of Votes - Whereupon it is declared in the Council that the said Thomas W. Hall is duly elected a Member of the Executive Council of the State of Maryland.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Frederick Gunn, Esquire, fifty Dollars as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Wilcox the sum of fifteen pounds for riding Express to Leonard Town and Montgomery Court House as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Abraham Gambell six pounds fifteen shillings for nine Months half pay due the first day of February last.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honble Allen Bowie Luchett, thirty one pounds thirteen shillings and four pence for Salary due as a Member of the Council to this day.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Eastern Shore be directed to cause Execution to issue against Benjamin Hatchison and his Securities and also against James O'Brien Executor of James.

By the Petition of Sarah Bright of Montgomery County it appears that the Court of Montgomery County at November Term eight hundred and three found her six hundred pounds of Tobacco for retailing Spirituous Liquors without License. The Petitioner states that she had no intention of violating the Law but being an ignorant Woman she was not conscious at the time that she had done so - that she is an intemperate poor Woman, and that at the time she was punished for the offence aforesaid she had two Daughters to support who were in a state of insanity, both of whom have remained in that state ever since, and are still dependent on her for support. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the same.
