James Masell, Richard Ireland Junior and Theodor Hodgkins were appointed Justices of the orphan Court for Calvert County and Commission issued accordingly.

Saturday December the 20. 1806

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Rerdy of Chisler. Thomas W. Hall, Lewis Duvall and James Nabb.

A letter was received this day from the Honourable Philip Reed dated the 17th Instant resigning his Seat in Council. Whereupon the Council immediately thereupon proceeded to elect another Member in his place the Ballots being deposited in the Ballot Box: on examination thereof it appeared that James Butcher Esquire, had won the vote. Whereupon it is declared in the Council that the said James Butcher Esq. is duly elected a Member of the Executive Council of the State of Maryland.
