The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and The Honble Secretary
of the Council Thomas W. Hall, Lewis Duwall and James Butcher

Resolved, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore be directed not to bring suit
against Thomas Parley, Esquire, late Sheriff of Baltimore County for a balance
due the State until the first day of July next.

The Council resumed the consideration of the appointment of Justices of the
Peace and other officers directed by the Constitution and Law to be appointed annu-
ally and not having come to a conclusion postponed the further consideration
till to Morrow.
