

Monday March the 11. 1811

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and The Honorable John Stephen, Reverdy G. Huselin and Thomas W. Hall.

Fredrick Tilghman was appointed Coroner for Washington County in the room of Charles Carroll resigned and Commission issued to him accordingly.

James Byrn was appointed a Justice of the Levy Court for Caroline County and Commission issued to A. Lemby Junr. Henry Bruney, James Byrn, John Boon, Jacob Wright of Lemuel, Henry Duver, Thomas Hardcastle, as Justices of the Levy Court for said County.

Robert Gosuch, Francis Snowden, John T. Worthington, Doctor Thomas Johnson, Thomas Love, Thomas Lemmon, James Brays, William B. Goldsmith, Benjamin Wilson Long Green, John Bankson, and John Buck of Benjamin were appointed and Commissioned Justices of the Levy Court for Baltimore County.
