The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble George E. Mitchell John Stephen Thomas W. Hall and Reverdy G. Huselen.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Shaw the sum of seven hundred and fifty Dollars in part of his compensation for binding Killys compilation of English Statutes to be by him accounted for

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Maid well one hundred and fifty seven Dollars and seventy five cents in full of his allowance and expenses for bringing Jesse Homer from the State of Virginia and James Stewart from the District of Columbia both fugitives from the Justice of this State as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Doctor Richard W. Hall two hundred and eleven dollars and forty one cents it being the amount of his Medical Account for visiting and examining and for the the Passengers confined in the Penitentiary House from November the twenty first eighteen hundred and eleven to the third Instant as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mr. Charles Holland seventeen Shillings and
