

The application which was made to them on the part of said Elizabeth was granted to the said John Walters Letter of Administration on his said deceased Brothers Estate: that the said John Walters employed a certain Thomas Littlejohn to reside on the deceaseds house in which was left a few days after his death by the said Elizabeth Heide, alias Walter) to take care of his effects and not to suffer them to be removed by any person whatsoever without the said John Walters order which he the said Littlejohn continued to do for the space of two Months: that said John Walter at the expiration of which period having become suspicious that said Littlejohn would betray his trust, by delivering the deceaseds effects into the hands of said Kummel discharged him and employed a certain Thomas Conington to take his place which he did and remained on the premises until the fourteenth day of October last when he was ordered by said Kummel to leave the House, which order he obeyed and immediately went to said John Walter and informed him of what had happened: that said John Walter then employed the Petitioners to go and take possession of the said House which they accordingly did about twelve o'clock on the Night of the last mentioned day, and continued to remain there until the next Morning, when said Kummel came to them and demanded admision, which they refused to grant observing to him at the same time that they had been particularly requested by their Brother not to suffer any person to enter without his order. that said Kummel notwithstanding the repeated and earnest solicitations of the Petitioners to quit the premises still persisted in his endeavours to enter which produced said a fault and Battery. The Petitioners state that they are young and altogether dependant on their characters and personal exertions for support. that they are totally unable to discharge said fines and that without the interposition of the Executive they must inevitably be consigned to the ignominy and disgrace of a long and painful imprisonment. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of a number of respectable persons inhabitants of Baltimore County do remit thirty seven Dollars and fifty cents of each of the said fines.
