

ordered that Thomas Harris Junior Esquire be authorized to cause an additional case to be made and fixed in the room in which the Court of Appeals sits and that forty Dollars be appropriated for that purpose out of the Contingent Fund.

By the Petition of Thomas White of Prince Georges County accompanied by transcripts from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he was fined by the said Court at September Term eighteen hundred and eleven in one case and at April Term Instant in three cases the sum of six pounds Current Money in each case. The Petitioner states that being old and unable to support himself by labour and his Wife being also far advanced in years - his said Wife in order to obtain the means of procuring the absolute Necessaries of life did sell a small quantity of Whiskey under a belief that from their poverty infirmities and obscurity in life no person would ever think of presenting the petitioner for an expedient which was adapted to supersede the necessity of begging. The Petitioner states that he is wholly unable to pay the said fines and that in consequence of not being able to give security for the first has remained in Jail ever since September Term. The Board on consideration of the poverty and long confinement of the Petitioner which have been satisfactorily proved and from the recommendation of the Chief and two Associate Justices of the Court of the said County do remit the whole of the said fines.
