Ordered that the Keeper of the Magazine at Baltimore be directed to deliver all the Powder belonging to the State to Captain George and John Barber

Henry Baer was appointed coroner for Frederick County and commission issued to him accordingly.

Josiah Polk was appointed clerk of Somerset County Court in the room of William Dore dead to hold the said office until the meeting of the next Court of the said County.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Henry P. Hall twenty nine Dollars and eighteen and three fourths cents for riding express as per accounts passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Luyon five Dollars for riding express as per account passed.
