Ordered that the Armourer at Frederick Town deliver to Captain Stephen Steiner seventy five Stand of Arms complete for the use of the Uniform Company commanded by him.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Wilson Editor of the Sun thirty two Dollars for printing done for the State as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Henry Foxall one hundred and forty three Dollars for two six pound Iron Field Pieces as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain George Little thirty one Swords and thirty one Pistols for the use of the Troop of Horse commanded by him.

John Ragan Junior was appointed Coroner for Washington County in the room of Robert Douglass resigned and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Joseph Dawson the sum of ten Dollars for one quarters half pay due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Merian Pinkney three Dollars as per Account passed by the Auditor General.
