

William Hayward, Solomon Dickerson and Doctor William C. Seth as Justices of the  
orphans Court for the said County.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Nathan Lavering the sum  
of twelve Dollars for storage of Powder belonging to the State as per account passed  
by the Auditor General.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonas Green Esquire  
the sum of forty one Dollars and sixty two and a half cents for printing done for the  
State as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain James  
Lamerell the sum of twenty two pounds less shillings for one quarters half  
pay due the first Instant.

By the Petition of Henry S. Gates of Charles County accompanied by a Trans-  
cript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he was  
fined by the said Court at March Term eighteen hundred and ten the sum  
of eighty Dollars for being the Bearer of a Challenge from John Maddox to  
Benjamin Lancaster to fight a Duel. The Petitioner states that solely with a  
view of accommodating an unfortunate difference which subsisted between the  
said John Maddox and Benjamin Lancaster was induced to be the Bearer  
of the said Challenge. That a presentment was found by the Grand Jury  
against the Petitioner and the said Maddox for said offence and upon the  
trial thereof was acquitted and the Petitioner convicted. The Board on consid-  
eration thereof and from the recommendation of a number of respectable persons  
inhabitants of the said County do remit the said fine of eighty Dollars.

By the Petition of Jacob Grove accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceeding  
of Frederick County Court it appears that he was fined by the said Court at August  
Term eighteen hundred and twelve the quantity of six hundred pounds of Tobacco

states that at the last August Term antecedent to the February Term at which the  
presentments were found against him, he was himself sick crippled and

reason of which he confesses he kept ordnance for sale.
