The Petitioner states that he has been for many years in the habit of retailing under a licence properly and regularly procured. That at September Term eighteen hundred and eight he went on to the Clerk of Anne Arundel County Court by the honorable Richard Ridgely the sum required by law from Retailers for the purpose of procuring a licence and believing that a licence had issued continued to act as a Retailer as usual, until he was informed by the said Ridgely that no licence had issued in consequence of his being compelled unexpectedly to return home by reason of the death of his sister which happened during Court and that the offence for which he has been fined was committed during the interval of the said Ridgely's departure from home and his return. The Petitioner states that at the time he acted as a Retailer he had no doubt a licence had been procured for him by the said Ridgely. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fine of six pounds Current Money.
