The Petitioner states that the violation of the law on his part was done through ignorance and misplaced confidence in the opinion of others. That he is very poor and infirm with a family to maintain. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said two fines of six pounds Current Money each.
