

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay, to Assembly  
Jump Agent for the collection of public Arms two hundred dollars  
to be by him accounted for.

Memorandum of the agreement, with Benjamin Pindle  
Agent for the collection of public Arms. That the said Pindle in  
consideration of the sum of one dollar and a half allowed on  
each musket and Rifle returned to the Armourer, undertake  
to pay and discharge all the persons whom he has employed to  
collect or transport the said Arms: and all accounts which he has  
contracted with said persons either in his own name or the name  
of the State. The understanding is that the above agreement is  
to extend only to the Arms now collected. and includes one  
hundred and seventy five stand delivered to Col. Waters.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore  
pay to Benjamin Pindle, one thousand and seventy three  
dollars being balance due on settlement of account for delivering  
one thousand and seven hundred and eighty two Stand of Arms.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to  
General Perry Benson, sixty dollars, for one quarters half pay  
due the first day of November last.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay, to Mrs.  
Rebecca Forrest, ninety dollars, for one quarters pension due her under a  
Resolution of the Legislature, passed at October Session 1780.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mrs.  
Ann LeVacher forty dollars for one quarters half pay due the first  
of November under the provisions of an act of Assembly, passed  
November Session 1785.
